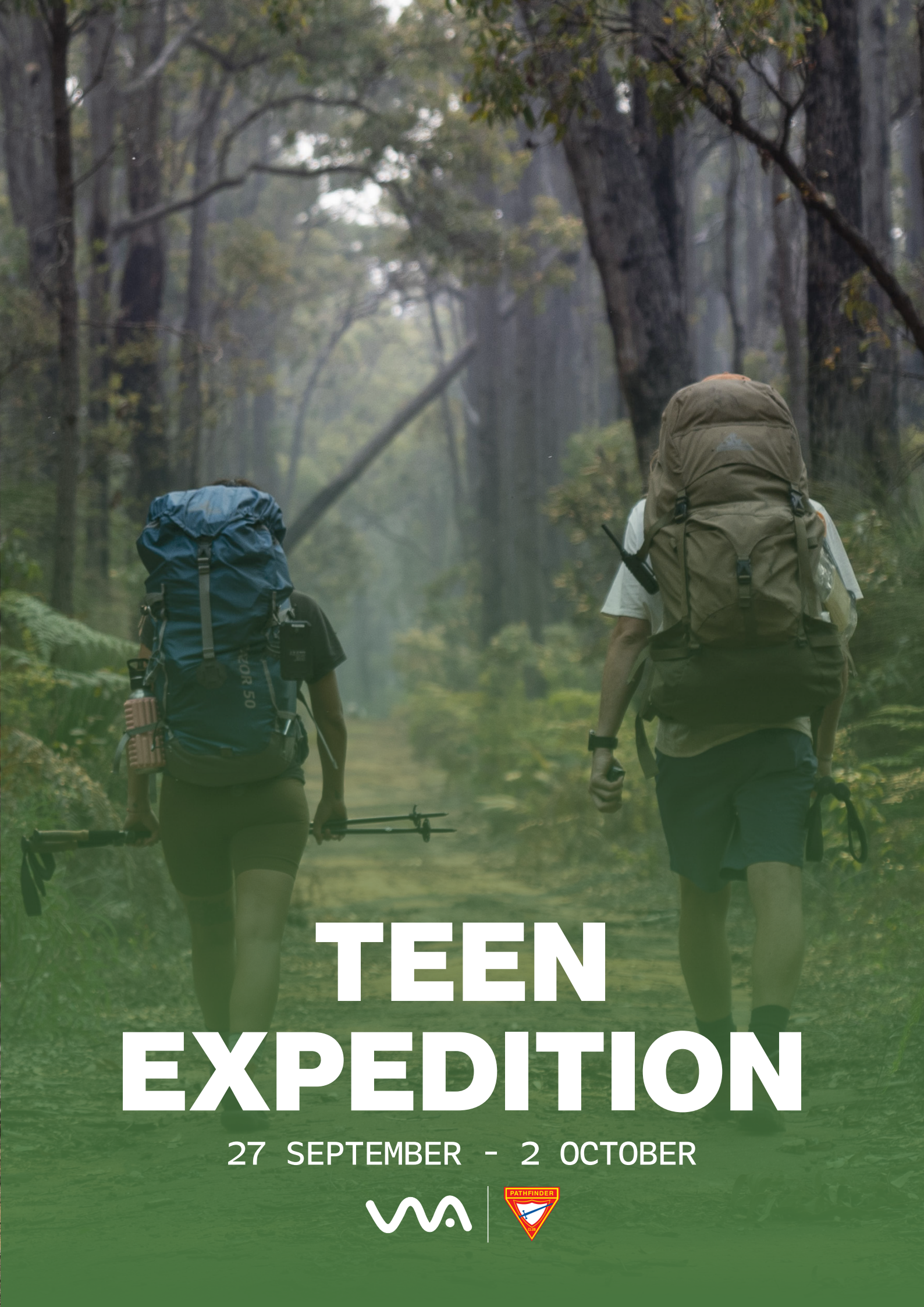

WHEN

Sunday, 27 September to Friday, 2 October

WHERE

The event will be held in Peel & Murray region. Attendees will be transported by bus to and from the location.

COST

Attendee Fee: \$150 per person

Attendee's must bring a bike or hire a bike from the Conference

Bike Hire Fee: \$75 per person (limited bikes available - first in first served)

Each person is to bring a Mountain or Trail Bike that is suitable for bush trail tracks. This is a major part of the Expedition that each teen is required to bring!

We encourage attendees to talk to their church boards and Pathfinder Clubs for financial support.

WHO

Pathfinders who are 13-16 years of age. Those working toward their Green Beret will be given first preference.

TRANSPORT & REGISTRATION
